Sister Louise Boyle Rites In Pittsburgh

Solemn requiem high mass for the Sister M. Louise Boyle, former resident of this city will be sung, Tuesday at 10 a. m. in the chapel of the Mother House of Sisters of St. Joseph, Baden, Pa. Sister Louise was a former superior at St. Joseph's hospital in Pittsburgh, where she died Saturday, after a long illness.

Born in Middlesboro, England, February 3, 1878, Sister Louise was a daughter of the late Thomas and Catherine Rowe Boyle, who settled in New Castle when she was very young.

She entered the Sisters of St. Joseph in 1897. From 1925 to 1928 she was superintendent of St. Joseph's hospital. Then for six years she was principal at Mt. Gallitzin Academy, Baden. Her teaching assignments included St. Canice and Holy Rosary schools here.

Surviving are three brothers, Michael and George Boyle, both of New Castle, and Phillip Boyle, of Pittsburgh, and a sister, Miss Alice Boyle, a nurse in Cleveland.

Friends are being received at the Mother House of her order in Baden. Burial will be in the community cemetery there.
