

## DEATHS OF THE DAY

### Thomas Boyle.

The funeral of Thomas Boyle, who died at the Shenango Valley hospital Monday afternoon as a result of injuries received in a runaway accident in the Seventh ward, will take place from St. Mary's church Thursday morning, mass being said at 9 o'clock.

Mr. Boyle, who was one of the best known residents of Spring Hill, Union township, was nearly 57 years of age. He was born in county Armagh, Ireland, 57 years ago next October. He was married in Middlesboro, England, 35 years ago, and came to America 26 years ago and took up his residence in Union township where he had since resided.

Mr. Boyle was for many years a furnace worker, but about two months ago went into the wholesale milk business and it was while following this vocation that he met with the injuries which caused his death.

The deceased is survived by his wife and the following children: Michael J. Boyle of New Castle, Mrs. Joseph Farrell of Pittsburg, Sister Louise of St. Joseph's order, Baden Pa., Thomas P., Mrs. J. J. Boyle, Philip, M., Francis X., Alice and George, all of this city. He is also survived by three grandchildren.
